The new plant is currently under construction in Commerce Park, Leesburg, Florida. The 65,000 SF indoor facility features a state of the art concrete batching system, automated concrete delivery equipment, dry cast technology, accelerated curing and specialized product handling equipment.

Hollow-core slabs are prefabricated concrete building components that are used as floor and roof units for all types of commercial buildings. They are routinely used for construction of apartments, condominiums, hotels, motels, assisted living housing, medical clinics and schools. Products manufactured in this new plant will be delivered to construction projects throughout the State of Florida and the Caribbean.



Coreslab Structures is a privately held company founded in 1975. Coreslab currently operates seventeen (17) manufacturing facilities in North America producing a broad range of high quality structural and architectural precast/prestressed concrete products and systems for use in virtually all types of construction projects.

The new plant is projected to begin production in the third quarter of 2017. At full production capacity, the plant is expected to create jobs for 55 employees.
